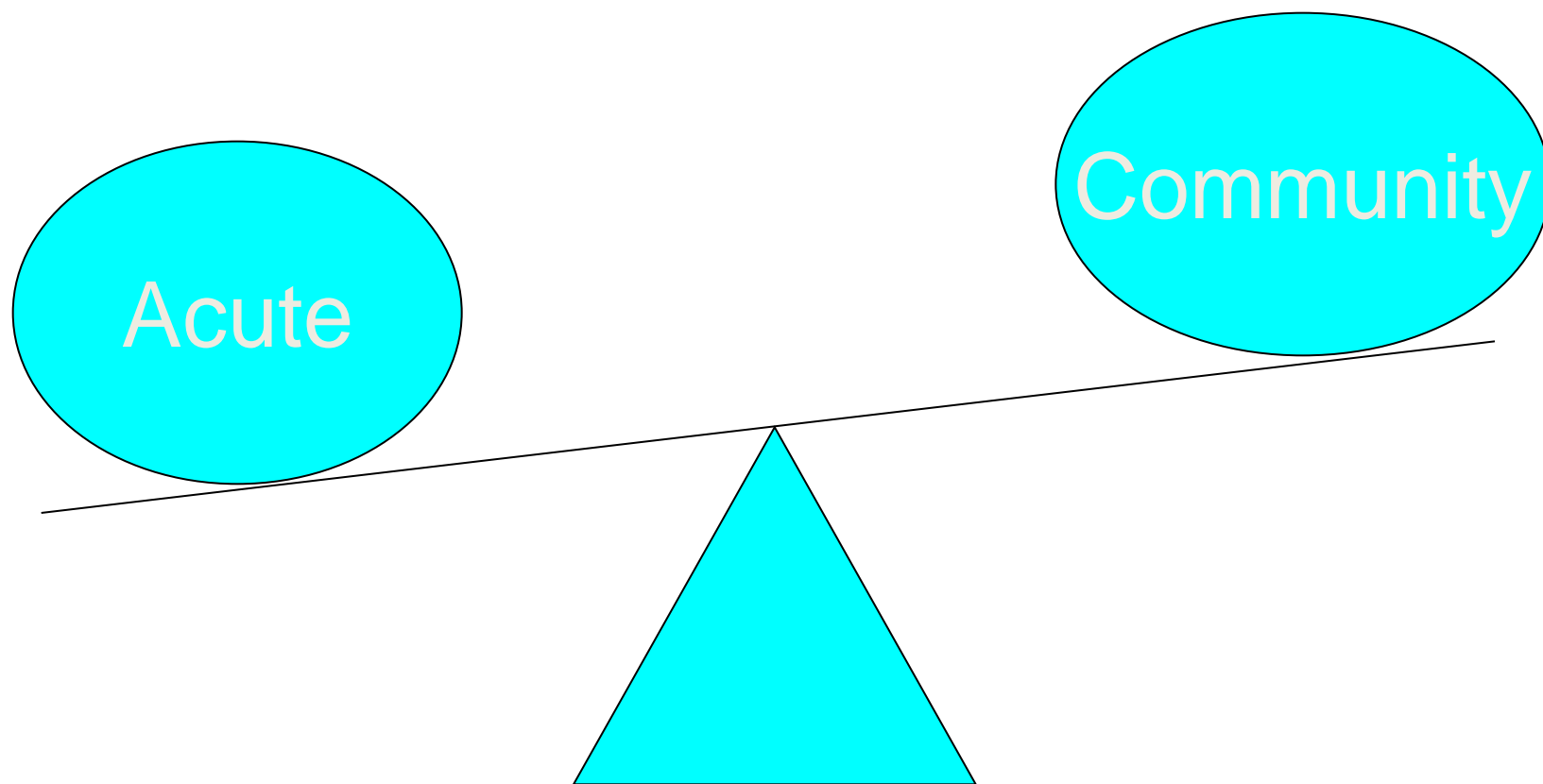

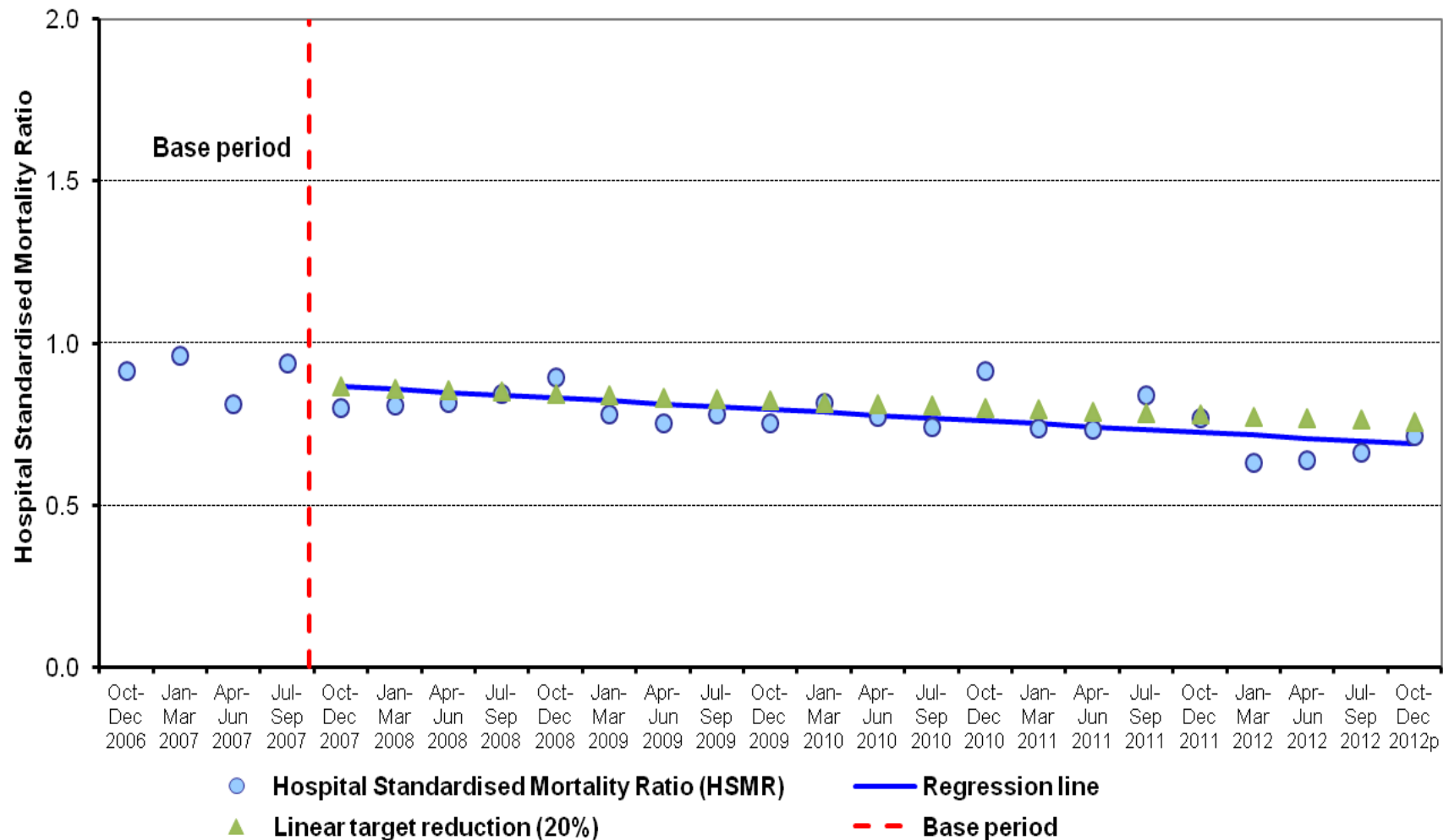

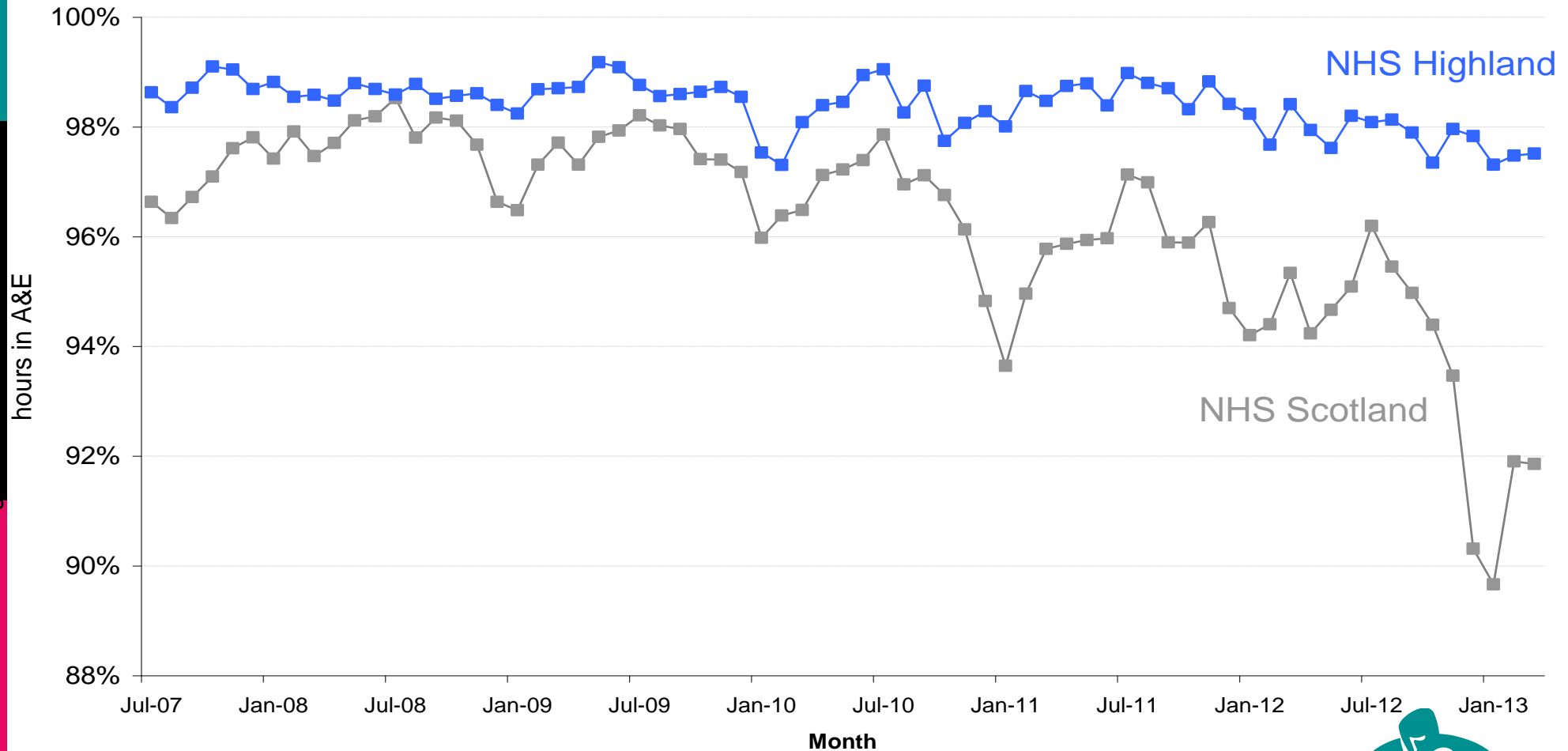

I was wondering if you can feel dementia.

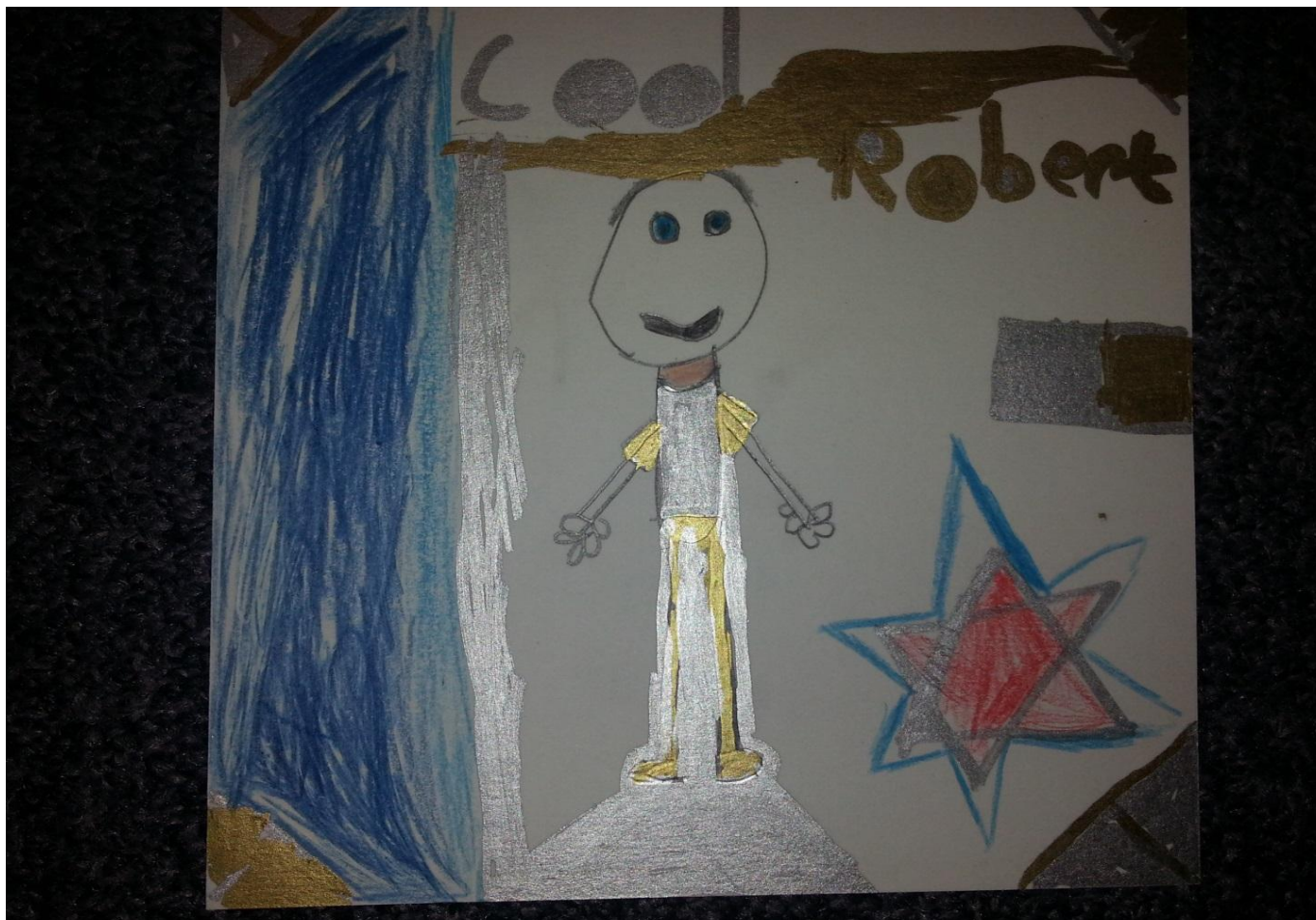
I thought that Robert was really nice and cool.
