#### **Engaging the community**

**Community Taskforce Volunteers** - one-off or very short-term practical support to individuals where there is no family, statutory or third sector support available

- Engaged 524 volunteers; current pool of 457
- Since first CTVs deployed in May 2020, **6200**+ deployments
