A Vision For Scotland








Definition

Especially Vulnerable Populations



RM - describes the principles of care

VBH&C - focus on outcomes which matter to patients

VBH&C - focus on sustainability (financial, environmental, system)

VBH&C - delivered by practising RM

VBH&C - requires multiprofessional working and measurement
