Under the theme *Collaboration for Change*, we would like to invite our members to display a poster at our conference on the 28th October with a focus on your organisation's role in collaborating to tackle health inequalities, creating fairer health and wellbeing in Scottish Communities.

Whether it's working across sectors, alongside communities, and in partnership, through community engagement, advocacy, or other approaches, we are asking you to create a visualisation of how your work is collaborative and some subsequent positive outcomes.

We will select shortlisted finalists to display their poster on the day of the conference. Following a live audience vote, the winner will be selected and announced on the day! As a finalist, you'll get:

What size should it be?	A0 size, printed and brought on the day of the conference. Please also send us an electronic PDF.
What should be included?	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The title of your work.• A note of the organisations and individuals involved.• A short explanation of the work and/or outcomes.
What style should it be?	Be as creative as you like! Please use a range of techniques and materials as long as it is A0 size so that it can be displayed on a poster board at the conference.
Permission	<p>Please ensure you have permission from all organisations and individuals named on the poster to use any images, data or wider content and intellectual property.</p> <p>By submitting your application, you are agreeing to VHS holding the data you have provided. We will never share your data and it will be stored securely. You can view our privacy policy at https://vhscotland.org.uk/privacy/</p>
Timeline and Deadlines	<p>We will be in touch shortly after the 2nd September deadline to advise if you are successful.</p> <p>The final poster design should be confirmed and submitted to VHS electronically as a PDF by the 3th October.</p> <p>The final copy of the A0 poster has to be printed by the entrant and brought on the day to the conference.</p> <p>The winner will be announced on the day of the conference (28 October 2025).</p>
