







Referral Data

- Wider range of referral sources





Referrals by practice and area Yearly Summary 24/25



Onward referrals


- Onward referrals helps to identify service gaps
- Appointment time and non appointment time demonstrates how CLWs use their time






Health Service Usage & Cost Benefit Analysis

- Analysis conducted on impact on Primary
 Health Care and potential savings through a
 Health service usage and Cost Benefit
 Analysis
- Year 23/24 shows a 34.25% reduction and potential saving of £72000
- Year 2023/24 had Shows 19% reduction in appointments (averaged across 4 practices) over a period of 6 months equating to £39,740 saving over a full year
- Smaller reduction than evidenced last year coincides with increase in referrals for those with chronic conditions





Wellbeing Evaluation

 New Wellbeing evaluation introduced this year to better evaluate the impact of CLWs on individuals that they support

- ONS4 Wellbeing evaluation tool used
- 47% increase in Wellbeing for those who had worked with CLWs
